WATER UPDATE

WE HAVE BEEN ABLE TO PROCESS ENOUGH WATER TO FILL ALL OF OUR WATER TANKS FOR THE FIRST TIME IN MONTHS. THE IRON LEVEL IN OUR RAW WATER SOURCE HAS DROPPED TO A LEVEL THAT IT IS EASIER TO FILTER OUT.

IT WAS SAID AT THE COHA PICNIC THIS LAST SATURDAY THAT WE ARE OFF OF WATER RESTRICTIONS AS TO WHEN YOU CAN AND CAN NOT WATER. THIS DOES NOT MEAN THAT WE ARE NOT STILL TRYING TO CONSERVE WATER.

Please continue to use your water wisely. This does not mean we can waste our most valuable resource.

JUNE 27, 2016 (UPDATED)

YES, WE ARE STILL IN THE WATER CONSERVATION MODE UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE. OUR TANKS ARE NOW FULL. WE ARE LOOKING FOR ADDITIONAL LOCATIONS FOR WATER.

1. TIME OF USE FOR OUTDOR WATERING. **7PM TO 7AM**
2. DAYS OF USE have been **CANCELLED** :
3. **NO WASHING OF DRIVEWAY**
4. **NO OPEN HOSES** (MUST HAVE A CLOSEABLE NOZZLE)
5. OUTSIDE WATERING SHOULD NOT RUN DOWN THE STREET.
6. VIOLATIONS ARE TO BE REPORTED TO THE WATER DISTRICT OFFICE AT 707-254-7796. ALL VIOLATIONS WILL BE VERIFIED.
7. THERE STILL CAN BE FINES FOR FLAGURANT VIOLATIONS UP TO \$500 FOR MULTIPLE OFFENSES.
